Ice Cream in a Bag

Ingredients:

- * 1 tbsp. Sugar
- * 1/2 cup Milk
- * 1/4 tspn. Vanilla
- * 6 tbsp. Rock Salt
- * 1 pint-size Ziploc plastic bag
- * 1 gallon-size Ziploc bag
- * Ice cubes

1. Fill the gallon-size Ziploc bag with ice until it is about half-full. Add the rock salt and seal the bag tight.
2. Put the milk, vanilla, and sugar into the pint-size Ziploc bag, and seal tightly.
3. Place the pint-size bag inside the gallon-size bag, and seal again carefully.
4. Shake the mixture until it thickens, about 5 minutes.
5. Wipe off the top of the small bag, then open carefully and enjoy your homemade icecream!

**Try the same recipe with chocolate milk or strawberry milk, just leave out the vanilla flavoring. Have fun! **
