How to Support the Novi Public Library

The Library is **supported annually by Novi taxpayers** through a dedicated millage. This millage supports the daily operations of the building, including services, resources, personnel, and maintenance. In 2007, a building bond was approved by voters to construct a new 59,000 sq. ft. library. In 2027, debt for the building will be completed, however, continued capital support to sustain its building and operations is ongoing and needed. Additional gifts and donations are essential to enhancing the core functions of the Library in the areas of collections, electronic resources, technology, programming/events, building and grounds, and outreach.

Every donation, large or small, makes a difference at NPL and is greatly appreciated. Donors are acknowledged through a thank you letter and recognition in the quarterly Engage magazine. Donations specifically for collections include a bookplate on the materials to be seen by readers. Library Administration coordinates with donors to ensure a thoughtful experience.

Since the opening of the new library, **visits to the building have increased 48% and check outs of items have increased 50%**. Thank you, Novi residents, for your amazing patronage and continuous use of the Library. Residents show their support every day, when visiting the building, attending a program, checking out materials or using the library's website to access online resources and downloadables. We built the Novi Library and residents came!
