### What You Need to Get This Card:

### **FOR ADULTS AGE 18 & OVER:**

 Your valid Michigan driver's license or stateissued ID showing your current Novi address (or address that pays Novi taxes).

### -0R-

- Your valid picture identification (passport or out-of-state driver's license). -AND-
- A current (dated within last three months) piece of mail showing your name.
  - If you cannot produce a valid piece of mail as proof of residency, the Library will mail a Verification Postcard to your Novi address, which can be returned in person to the Library as proof of residency at a later date.

### **FOR CHILDREN UNDER AGE 18:**

- A parent or legal guardian (official guardianship papers required) must register the child for a library card, with both parent and child present.
- Parent or legal guardian must present their valid Michigan driver's license and their NPL library card, which must be in good standing.
- Parents or legal guardians who sign the child's library card become the "Registered Parent" and have access to the account information and are responsible for all materials borrowed.

A Novi resident affected by special circumstances (i.e. temporarily or permanently homebound; exchange student or temporary resident residing in a host household of a Novi resident; etc.) who obtains a Sponsor who will take responsiblity for their library card. Either the Sponsor or the Sponsored Resident MUST be a Novi Resident.

### What You Need to Get This Card:

### FOR BOTH THE SPONSORED RESIDENT & THE SPONSOR:

 Your valid Michigan driver's license or state-issued ID showing your current Novi address (or address that pays Novi taxes).

#### -OR-

- Your valid picture identification (passport or outof-state driver's license). -AND-
- A current (dated within last three months) piece of mail showing your name.
  - If you cannot produce a valid piece of mail as proof of residency, the Library will mail a Verification Postcard to your Novi address, which can be returned in person to the Library as proof of residency at a later date.

### Who Can Get This Card:

Business owners who may live in The Library Network (TLN) service area.

They can keep their home library card for personal use and obtain a **Novi Public Library card valid ONLY at NPL for business use.** 

### **What You Need to Get This Card:**

 Your valid Michigan driver's license, passport, or state-issued ID with your current home address.

#### -AND-

- Incorporation Papers -OR- Tax Bill (showing Novi address) that includes:
  - Owner's Name
  - Business Name
  - Business Address
  - NOT ACCEPTABLE: Business Cards or Business Utility Bills

### **Card Privileges**

- Card valid for 1 year
- Charge Limit: 100 items
- Holds Limit: 25 items
- Overdue Items Limit: 24 Items
- \$14.99 in fines suspends service
- 1 or more lost items suspends service

### **Who Can Get This Card:**

### A person employed in Novi.

They **cannot** live in The Library Network (TLN) service area and **cannot** have a home library card from either a shared system or standalone TLN library. **The NPL card is valid ONLY at NPL.** 

### What You Need to Get This Card:

 Your valid Michigan driver's license, passport, or state-issued ID with your current home address.

### -AND-

- One of the following (showing Novi address):
  - Current (dated within last three months)
     official business letter signed by the company
     or Human Resources representative.
  - Current (dated within last three months) paycheck
  - NOT ACCEPTABLE: Business Cards or Employee ID Badge

## Who Can Get This Card:

# A City of Novi employee may live in The Library Network (TLN) service area.

If the employee already has a library card from their home library within the TLN network (either shared system or standalone library), they are welcome to use that library card for most services at the Novi Public Library.

If they prefer full Novi Public Library services to those provided by their home library, they MUST give up their home library card for a Novi Public Library card and will receive full privileges valid ONLY NPL. They can only have one library card in the shared system.

### What You Need to Get This Card:

 Your valid Michigan driver's license, passport, or state-issued ID with your current home address.

### -AND-

• Official City of Novi employee badge.

### Who Can Get This Card:

# Non-Novi resident who may or may not live in The Library Network (TLN) service area.

If the non-resident already has a library card from their home library within the TLN network (either shared system or standalone library), they are welcome to use that library card for most services at the Novi Public Library.

If they prefer full Novi Public Library services to those provided by their home library, they MUST give up their home library card for a Novi Public Library card and will receive full privileges valid ONLY at NPL, for an annual fee. They can only have one library card in the shared system.

Non-residents whose home library is not part of the TLN network may purchase a Novi Public Library card and will receive full privileges valid ONLY at NPL, for an annual fee.

The annual fee is stated in "Borrowing Periods, Renewal Limits, Holds, Fees & Guidelines."
